

# Twin Internships

Twin Internships are designed to fit individual student's needs and experience. Students are closely matched with Twin's internship providers in advance of arrival, wherever possible. Therefore it is essential that we receive full details of the student at time of booking, complete with a comprehensive CV.

Twin provides various levels of internship; from unpaid, to some with expenses stipends, to those that are fully paid; and from short term to long term placements. We have to emphasise to students that what we offer them in this range will very much depend on their level of experience, subject area, length and timing of their internship booking, age, education and level of English language. It is not, therefore a foregone conclusion that they can just walk into any specific type of internship, or indeed a paid placement, it will depend on all these factors.

Several of our programmes involving internships have a study component, in fact some are part of academic programmes; others are pure internships. All will have a compulsory induction phase and post internship review phase at the student's designated Twin Centre, which are compulsory elements of the internship programme. Full attendance and a commitment to work and study are also paramount.

The English language level of the student is critical and we will ask applicants to provide proof of their level of English at the time of booking; the higher their internship aspirations, the higher their English language skills will need to be.

When we receive the booking form and documents we will carry out a telephone or video interview with the student to check their language level, credentials and intentions. If everything matches up we will offer them an internship placement according to their background.
