Level 2

Participants in this programme are generally young people over the age of 18 who are eager to improve their vocational skills at the same time as their English.*

# Hospitality Employment Programme

*Twin's Hospitality Employment Programme is a minimum 25-week programme for EU students to add to their existing work experience by securing a placement in the UK hospitality industry. Twin assesses the English ability and experience of candidates before they begin the programme so they can be matched to the right position. Twin's Hospitality Employment Programme affords candidates a great opportunity to broaden their knowledge of the hospitality industry at the same time as mixing with native English speakers.*

- Depending on English level and experience, a typical placement could be: trainee hotel manager, receptionist, waiter, bar tender, kitchen porter
- Candidates are placed in a variety of hotel environments and locations in the UK
- Minimum wage applies
- Accommodation and food arranged by the employer on a cost basis
- All applicants will be interviewed by telephone before being accepted on to this programme
